Anna C. Frerking, age 93 of Higginsville, Missouri died on Sunday, December 11, 2011, at Lafayette Regional Health Center in Lexington, Missouri.

Born Monday, April 22, 1918 in Sweet Springs, Missouri, she was the daughter of the late William Stockman, Sr. and the late Mary Steffens Stockman. Also preceded in death are four brothers, Lawrence, Elmer, Roy and William Stockman, Jr.
