July 2, 1940 - February 28, 2022

Charles Bennett "Ben" Caylor, Sr., 81 of Corder, Missouri died on Monday, February 28, 2022, at his home.

He was born Tuesday, July 2, 1940 in Kansas City, Missouri, to the late Arthur Caylor and the late Laura Duchene (Rhodelander). Ben was the youngest of 13 children. He attended Central High School and married Susan (Points) Caylor in 1967. He lived on a farm in Aullville, Missouri for 40 plus years. He moved to Corder 13 years ago.

As a young man he delivered milk in Kansas City. He later worked in pest control as an exterminator and finally in sales and advertising for Classic Outdoor Advertising - David & Kristy Gash, until his retirement. He was very active in the Higginsville Jaycees and was a national recruiter. He will be greatly missed.
