William Thomas "Bill" Wegener, 86 of Higginsville, Missouri passed away on Tuesday, October 4, 2022, surrounded by family at his home.

He was born Thursday, March 26, 1936 in Lexington, Missouri, to the late Gilbert Wegener and the late Dorothy Wegener (Owen). He graduated from Higginsville High School - class of 1953. After school he worked on his father's farm. Bill enlisted in the United States Army in 1956 and served his country proudly. He married Violet (McCoy) Wegener on September 12, 1959. Bill started working at Lake City Ammunition Plant in 1963 and gave 30+ years until his retirement. After retirement Bill never slowed down.
