Carl D. Gosoroski, age 75, of Higginsville, Missouri passed away peacefully July 5, 2015 at Lees Summit Medical Center.

Born April 24, 1940 to the late Joseph and Myrtle Gosoroski, he lived most of his life in Higginsville. He graduated from Lafayette County C1 High School in 1958.
