Carolyn Sue (Glidewell) Hobbs, 74 years old, of Higginsville, Missouri, formerly of Milan Missouri, passed away on November 10, 2023 at her home. She was born July 3, 1949 in Corydon, Iowa to Allen and Virginia (Neff) Glidewell. Carolyn's family moved to Milan during her early childhood and she graduated from Milan C-II High School in 1968. 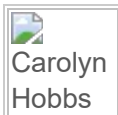
