Charles C. Miller, age 78 of Higginsville, Missouri died on Tuesday, October 9, 2012, at his home.

Born Wednesday, January 31, 1934 in Knob Noster, Missouri, he was the son of Everett Miller and Lorene Bybee Miller. He married JoAn Hibner November 21, 1981.

Mr. Miller worked at the Knob Noster Bank and later worked at the Bank of Higginsville, where he worked for 25 years. He also worked part time at Mike Keith Insurance for 18 years. He retired in 2012 and has lived in Higginsville since 1963. He served in the U.S. Army from 1953 until 1955 ranking Sp3(T). He was a Veteran of Korea.
