Connie S. Thaller, age 63 of Higginsville, Missouri died Wednesday, October 15, 2014, at Golden Living Center-New Haven in Odessa, Missouri.

Born Friday, March 23, 1951 in Independence, Missouri, she was the daughter of the late David Kegley and the late June (Willard) Kegley. She and Arthur B. Thaller were united in marriage June 14, 1986.

Connie worked in dietary food service at Higginsville Habilitation Center, retiring in 2010. She became owner of Ceramic Corner in Higginsville in 1993 where she taught ceramics, oil painting and basket weaving. A member of Salem United Church of Christ, she was a charter member of the handbell choir and was a former Sunday school teacher at Salem and Zion Lutheran Church in Corder, Missouri. She graduated from Lafayette C-1 High School in 1969 and lived most of her life in the Corder and Higginsville area. She worked a number of years at Biesemeyer's Market in Corder.

Very active in the community, Connie was a member of Higginsville Chamber of Commerce and booth chairman for the Higginsville Country Fair.

Preceding her in death are her parents, and one brother, David Kegley.
