Craig Willard Nienhueser, 68 of Higginsville, Missouri, passed away on Friday, June 13, 2025, at Lafayette Regional Health Center in Lexington, Missouri. He was born Sunday, July 29, 1956 in Lexington and was the son of the late Willard Nienhueser and the late Doris (Hackett) Hinkle. Craig was a graduate of Truman High School in Independence, Missouri. He married Debbie (Boylan) Nienhueser on July 11, 1980, they spent almost 45 years together. Craig worked as a plant supervisor in the chemical manufacturing industry. When his brother Mark passed away, he inherited his brother's bar in Independence. He was a huge sports fan and couldn't wait for Chiefs season to start so he could cheer on the Chiefs. He was always a bright smile in any crowd, a great friend to socialize with, and a loving husband, father, and grandfather. He will be deeply missed by all who knew and loved him.

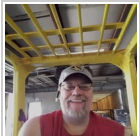
