Curt Randall Gockel, age 67 of Gardner, Kansas died on Tuesday, March 16, 2010,

Curt was born October 1, 1942 in Seneca, Kansas; he was the son of the late John Gockel and Genevieve Siess Gockel.

He lived in Baileyville, Kansas until age 13 when his family moved to Seneca. He also lived briefly in Higginsville Missouri, and lived most of his life in the Kansas City area. Curt was of the Catholic faith. He graduated from St. Peter and Paul High School in Seneca and received his Bachelor's degree from Kansas State University in 1964. He was a member of Alpha Kappa Lambda fraternity. He taught high school in North Kansas City, worked for Martin Marietta in Denver Colorado and the J.C. Penney Co. He served in the Kansas National Guard.

Curt was active in tennis and basketball as well as an avid fan of professional baseball, basketball and of the St. Louis Cardinals.

He was preceded in death by his father, John Gockel and his sister, Tura Gockel Sommerville.
