Today would be my dad's birthday. I really wish I'd known him better but he and my mother divorced when I was barely 3yrs old. Grandma Dora is the only one that kept in touch all the way till she passed away when I was about 22 yrs old. After that I only seen my father on two other occasions. First he and his wife at that time, Bonnie, came to Mississippi to visit me and my new wife, Chastity. She's the one contacted my father and after is when they drove down for a weekend. About a year later, he and Bonnie and Grandma Dora drove down once more because my grandma wanted to see me before she passed. My visit with her was short because they stayed in a motel and her health wasn't very good and she couldn't get out and drive 50 miles to Vicksburg to the casinos where my father wanted to go during there visit. That visit was the last time to see my father. We only talked a couple times after that but I found out a few years later he'd left his wife and married Susan but I never heard from him again. I tried calling once but got my brother, darrell jr.'s answering machine, when he called me back he told me that he'd told my father that he thought I was trying to get in touch and our father told him, "I don't know why, I haven't heard from him since I sent him the money Grandma left for him." Money , if actually left for me, that I never received. I haven't spoken with anyone there since. And then a few months ago, a add popped up on an app saying, "search any name for obituary" and I'd had my father on my mine a lot lately wondering if he was still living and I typed in his name... That's how I learned of his passing. And to this day, no one has contacted me to inform me of his death. Thanks a lot family! That's really being thoughtful! Well that's okay since you never knew me anyway. Why I was even mentioned as one of his children at his funeral I don't know. But if anyone reads this I will say I'm not mad about it but was heartbroken and hurt. Whatever the reason no one felt necessary to notify me, whether he may have also left me anything (which I doubt) like my grandma did that I never received, or because they may have been embarrassed by me for whatever reason. I'm gonna be fine like I have been for 54yrs now without a dad. My life may have been much different... probably even better... I only wish I'd had my father as a dad all those years.
