David L. Cunningham, age 61 of Warrensburg, Missouri died on Tuesday, April 28, 2015, at Western Missouri Medical Center in Warrensburg.

Born Monday, March 15, 1954 in El Dorado, Kansas, he was the son of the late Robert Bruce Cunningham and the late Bonnie Jean (Volesky) Cunningham. Also preceding him in death is one brother, John Charles Cunningham.
