



Dr. D.D. Beschnett

March 24, 1928 - December 15, 2010

Dr. D. D. Beschnett, age 82 of Concordia, Missouri, formerly of Higginsville, Missouri, died on Wednesday, December 15, 2010, at Lutheran Nursing Home in Concordia.

Born Saturday, March 24, 1928 in Mankato, Minnesota, he was the son of the late William R. Beschnett and the late Renata Weichmann Beschnett. He married Johanna Roemhildt June 26, 1949. She preceded him in death January 7, 1996. Also preceded in death is his parents and a daughter, Teresa Beschnett.

He was a veteran and served as a Pfc in the Army Military Police from 1946 until 1947. He worked as a Chiropractor in Higginsville for over 42 years retiring in 1999. He lived in Higginsville for 50 years, moving to Concordia in 2007. He was of the Lutheran faith.

He was a member of Higginsville V.F.W. and Higginsville American Legion Post #223.
