Don R. Pragman, age 77 of Higginsville, Missouri died on Saturday, December 22, 2012, at Village House Hospice in Lee's Summit, Missouri.

Born Saturday, June 15, 1935 in Corder, Missouri, he was the son of the late Elmer Pragman and the late Anna Huddleston Pragman. Also preceded in death is a sister, Joyce Lorenz. He married Emika Nagano November 27, 1967.

Mr. Pragman moved to Higginsville in 1973 after 20 years of military service in the U.S. Marine Corp where he served during the Korean and Vietnam wars. He then worked 25 years at the Weigh Scales for the Missouri Highway Patrol, retiring in 1997. He was a member of the Corder V.F.W.

Surviving are his wife Emika Pragman and one brother, Bob (Peggy) Pragman of Higginsville.

A Funeral service will be held at 2:00 P.M. on Wednesday, December 26, 2012 at Hoefler Chapel, 1600 Main St. Higginsville with the Pastor Betty Thaller officiating, Sharon Pragman as organist and Kurt Lorenz as Liturgist.
