Edwin "Bill" Dysart, age 88 of Higginsville, Missouri died on Wednesday, December 3, 2014 at Meyer Care Center in Higginsville.

Born Monday, October 11, 1926 in Corder, Missouri, he was the son of the late Edwin Dysart and the late Mary (Whinn) Dysart. He and Alice Louise Schumaker were united in marriage December 4, 1947 and she preceded him in death October 26, 1970. On February 27, 1972 Bill and Ethol (McKee) Smith were united in marriage.

Bill was employed as a forklift operator at the Leeds General Motors Plant retiring in 1983. He also farmed. He and his wife moved to Higginsville from Waverly, Missouri in 2000.

A graduate of Dover High School and a veteran of the U.S. Army during WWII, he was a member of Dover Christian Church, the Higginsville American Legion Post 223 and a former member of the Dover Lions Club and Waverly Jaycees.
