Floyd Gale Elmore, age 69 of Kansas City, Missouri passed away on Thursday, April 15, 2021 at Centerpoint Medical Center in Independence, Missouri.

He was born on Sunday, January 6, 1952 in Marshall, Missouri, and was the son of the late Martin Lane Elmore Sr. and late Mamie (Fectic) Elmore.

Floyd grew up in Higginsville, MO and attended St. Paul Missionary Baptist Church in Higginsville. He was a graduate of Lafayette County C-1 High School - class of 1970, where he played basketball and ran track. Floyd married Sherry Fields on October 8, 1979 and from this union two sons were born.

Floyd worked as a Skilled Laborer for Local Union #1290, KC Concrete and Asphalt, was a supervisor for Bruenings Nursery and Marshall Evergreen, and did other concrete and landscaping jobs for himself.

Floyd loved playing and watching basketball and football. He played town team basketball with his brothers and friends. He also never missed any of his sons' basketball games, football games, or track meets. He loved playing his guitar and singing, was an avid pool player, and was a competitive guy who could meet any challenge.

Floyd was a devoted husband, father, and grandfather. He was a mentor to a lot of young men and was always willing to help anyone. He was a man of many words and always spoke his mind.
