



## Frank Fulkerson Haston

August 16, 1930 - October 19, 2010

Frank Fulkerson Haston, age 80 of Higginsville, Missouri died on Tuesday, October 19, 2010, at NorthCare Hospice House in North Kansas City, Missouri.

Born Saturday, August 16, 1930 in Higginsville, Missouri, he was the son of the late Norman Cameron Haston and the late Elizabeth Permelia Young Haston. He married Patricia R. McNatt on June 14, 1952.

He served as a Sergeant(T) in the U.S. Army from 1952 until 1954 & a Veteran of Korea. He received a Master's in Extension Education in 1968 at University of Missouri-Columbia. He moved to Higginsville from Rolla, Missouri in 1986.

Frank was a member of Higginsville Rotary Club, over 50-year member of the Higginsville Masonic Lodge, member of the Ararat Shrine in Kansas City, Missouri, the Missouri Association of Adult & Continuing Education where he received a distinguished service award in 1981, member of the National University Continuing Education Association, & Missouri Valley Adult Education Association.

He served as president of the Confederate Memorial Friends Association and was director with Foster Grandparents Program for a number of years. He

was a member of the Higginsville American Legion Post #223 & Salem United Church of Christ in Higginsville.

Surviving are his wife, Patricia M. Haston of the home in Higginsville; sons, Frederick Cameron(Lynn) Haston of Joplin, Missouri, Gregory Malcolm(Ronni) Haston of Branson, Missouri and James Frank(Lucinda) Haston of Higginsville; daughter, Tricia Ann(Jon) Jester of Liberty, Missouri; brother, Cameron Haston of Lenexa, Kansas; & seven grand children, Elizabeth Ann Jester, Amelia Suzanne Jester, HM3(FMF) Andrew James Haston, Pfc. Clifton Daniel Haston, Victoria Elizabeth Haston, Rosemary Grace Haston & Katherine Emelia Haston.

Preceded in death are his parents and one sister, Margaret Snyder.
