George Kenneth Wandell, age 87, of Higginsville, Missouri died on Wednesday, February 2, 2011, at The Living Center in Marshall, Missouri.

Born Sunday, April 29, 1923 in Bethany, Missouri, he was the son of Anton Wandell and Cora Smith Wandell. He married Darlene J. Reeve May 23, 1945. George served in the U.S. Navy during WWII, ranking Seaman. He worked as Supervisor of boiler maintenance at Wentworth Military Academy until his retirement April 30, 1992.
