Oscar Bransteitter, 79 of Higginsville, Missouri died on Wednesday, December 26, 2018, at Warrensburg Manor Care Center in Warrensburg, Missouri. Born Friday, August 18, 1939 in Coweta, Oklahoma, he was the son of the late Ray Bransteitter and the late Ethel Husley Bransteitter. He was the husband of Mary Bransteitter marrying August 19, 1962. He was a veteran of the United States Navy as a Beachmaster, assigned to Unit 1. He lived in Lexington, Missouri and worked for Lexington MFA for 43 years before moving to Higginsville in 2002.
