Gloria attended Higginsville High School, Kansas City University and the University of Missouri. Always active in politics, she served two terms as a Republican Election Commissioner in Hinds County before moving to Rankin County in 1975. She was a member of Pi Beta Phi sorority; and P.E.O. Sisterhood, an international women's organization of 250,000 members that provides educational opportunities for female students worldwide.

Her parents, Forrest A. and Gloria Hoefler, and her grandson, Christopher Taylor, preceded her in death.

She is survived by her husband of 64 years, Robert Stewart of the home in Brandon, Mississippi; daughter, Susan Ferber (Dale) of Brandon; son, Brian Stewart (Dawn) of Sarasota, Florida; and her beloved dog Reagan. Additionally she leaves behind her granddaughter, Shelley Eaton (Ray) of Brandon; and grandson Michael Ferber (Ileana) of the Woodlands, Texas. Her great grandson, Stewart Eaton and great granddaughters Avery Eaton, Isabella Ferber and Elisa Ferber also survive her. Also surviving is a brother, Forrest R. "Frosty" Hoefler; and Dorothy Hoefler of Higginsville, Missouri; as
