Gregory Carlton Guinn, 53 of Higginsville, Missouri died on Friday, February 27, 2015, at his home.

Born Wednesday, April 26, 1961 in Banning, California, he was the son of Nancy Doyle Walker Guinn and the late Herbert Carlton Guinn.

He moved from California to Warrensburg, MO in 1978, graduating from Warrensburg High School in 1979. He then attended college at Central Missouri State University also in Warrensburg.
