



## Helen Louise Schwarzer

November 8, 1919 - December 13, 2013

Helen Louise Schwarzer, age 94 of Higginsville, Missouri died on Friday, December 13, 2013, at Golden Living Center New Haven in Odessa, Missouri.

Born Saturday, November 8, 1919 in Concordia, Missouri, she was the daughter of Henry Schroeder and Florence E. (Lampe) Schroeder. She was united in marriage to Francis "Frank" Schwarzer Tuesday, June 30, 1942. He preceded her in death August 17, 1985. Also preceded in death are her parents.

Mrs. Schwarzer lived most of her life in Higginsville. She worked as Unit Director at the Higginsville Habilitation Center for 45 years, retiring in 2006. She was a 1937 graduate of Higginsville High School and then graduated from the Research School of Nursing and was the oldest active Registered Nurse in the state of Missouri, being licensed for 73 years.

She was a member of Higginsville American Legion Auxiliary, Higginsville Civic Club, Chamber of Commerce and Higginsville Habilitation Center Parent's Association.
