Henry A. "Bud" Laverentz, 83 of Warrensburg, Missouri died on Monday, February 29, 2016, at Research Medical Center in Kansas City, Missouri.

Born Friday, October 28, 1932 in Severance, Kansas, he was the son of the late Henry Laverentz and the late Anna Mattucks Laverentz. He married Shirley Pragman on August 9, 1958.
