



## Homer A. Steffens

September 21, 1930 - January 11, 2011

Homer A. Steffens, age 80, of Higginsville, Missouri died on Tuesday, January 11, 2011, at Meyer Care Center in Higginsville, Missouri.

Born Sunday, September 21, 1930 in Corder, Missouri, he was the son of Adolph William Steffens & Marie Carolina Nienhueser Steffens. He married Maxine E. Covey August 31, 1952. She preceded him in death February 2, 2008.
