March 14, 1916 - February 18, 2012

Irvin C. Kleinschmidt, age 95 of Corder, Missouri died on Saturday, February 18, 2012, at Harry S. Truman V.A. Hospital in Columbia, Missouri.

Born Tuesday, March 14, 1916 in Corder, Missouri, he was the son of the late Gilbert Charles Kleinschmidt and the late Delia E. (Liese) Kleinschmidt. He was married to Mary Katherine (Luehrs) Kleinschmidt on August 24, 1960. She preceeded him in death May 11, 2000. Also preceeded in death is a daughter Mary Catherine Bird and her husband Norman Bird.

He was the founder of Kleinschmidt's Western Store in Higginsville and lived most of his life in Corder. He served in the U.S. Army during WWII. . Irvin was a member of Corder United Methodist Church, a charter and lifetime member of the Corder V.F.W. Post 4288, and a member of the Higginsville American Legion Post 223. He also started the Higginsville Bowl.
