Jackie Kinkead, age 57 of Kansas City, Missouri died on Wednesday, December 3, 2014, at the Liberty Hospital in Liberty, Missouri.

Born Monday, October 21, 1957 in Lexington, Missouri, she was the daughter of Leonard Dale Schroeder and the late Barbara Ann (Wolpers) Schroeder. She and Greg Kinkead were united in marriage on April 30, 1979.

Jackie was employed as a Community Support Coordinator for Concerned Care, Inc., an agency that works with people with developmental disabilities, located in North Kansas City, Missouri. She lived in Kansas City, Missouri the past 32 years and was a member of the 1976 graduating class at Lafayette Co. C-1 High School in Higginsville. A four year breast cancer survivor, she was of the Lutheran faith.

Jackie was an avid reader, (mysteries, mostly), loved camping with her family and playing Candy Crush and Bejeweled internet games.

Surviving are her husband, Greg Kinkead of the home in Kansas City, Missouri; her father, Leonard Dale Schroeder of Lexington, Missouri; two sons, Colin Kinkead of Lathrop, Missouri, Clayton Kinkead and his wife, Grace Ventimiglia of Liberty, Missouri; and one brother, Mike Schroeder and his wife, Kris of Grain Valley, Missouri.

A Funeral service will be held at 2:30 P.M. on Sunday, December 7, 2014 at the Hoefer Chapel, 1600 Main St. Higginsville with Pastor Marcus Jaus officiating.
