March 31, 1929 - October 16, 2020

Josephine "Jojo" McCulloch, 91 of Higginsville, Missouri passed away on Friday, October 16, 2020, at Meyer Care Center in Higginsville.

She was born Sunday, March 31, 1929 in Mayview, Missouri, and was the daughter of the late Alfred Shier and the late Elberta (Stockton) Shier.
