Jon Ralph Alderton, 56 of Bates City, Missouri died on Sunday, July 12, 2020 at his home. He was born July 14, 1963 in Fremont, California and was the son of the late Virgil Alderton and Marilyn Schaefer (Manlove). Jon was a graduate of Odessa High School, class of 1982, and received a Certificate of Welding from Lex-La-Ray Area Vocational/Technical School in 1982.

He was employed in various job settings increasing his skills in welding, maintaining facilities, and repairing equipment. At Visteon (a Ford Motor Co. subsidiary) in Concordia, Missouri, he applied those talents until the plant's closing.
