



## Kathy Sue Brooks Hill

Kathy Sue Brooks Hill, age 63 of Higginsville, Missouri died on Tuesday, September 2, 2014, at Meyer Care Center in Higginsville.

Born Friday, August 10, 1951 in Clinton, Missouri, she was the daughter of the late William Albert Brooks and the late Gladys V. (Coleman) Brooks. Also preceded in death are three brothers, Gary, Albert and William A. Brooks Jr.; and one sister: Wanda Brooks.
