Keith H. Struchtemeyer, 64, of Higginsville, Missouri died on Monday, December 14, 2015, at St. Luke's Hospital in Kansas City, Missouri.

Born Wednesday, May 3, 1951, he was the son of Earl Daniel Struchtemeyer and the late Grace Johanna Tempel Struchtemeyer.
