Kenneth W. Moore, age 79 of Higginsville, Missouri died on Thursday, September 25, 2014, at his home.

Born Sunday, May 26, 1935 in Higginsville, he was the son of the late Heuby Moore and the late Lydia (Saunders) Moore. He and Bonnie J. Alspaugh were united in marriage on October 14, 1978.

Kenneth was a lifelong resident of Higginsville and a 1955 graduate of Higginsville High School. He retired from the U.S. Air Force on June 30, 1975 after serving from 1955-1975.
