



## Lambert J. Gieselman

Lambert J. Gieselman, age 89 of Higginsville, Missouri died on Sunday, March 15, 2015, at Meyer Care Center in Higginsville.

Born Friday, May 8, 1925 in Corder, Missouri, he was the son of the late Arthur Gieselman and the late Clara (Martens) Gieselman. He and Ruth Rinne were united in marriage on March 11, 1951.
