February 2, 1933 - March 3, 2014

Lawrence Harvey Hollis, age 81 of Higginsville, Missouri died on Monday, March 3, 2014, at Meyer Care Center in Higginsville.

Born Thursday, February 2, 1933 in Waverly, Missouri, he was the son of the late Floyd Hollis and the late Dorothy (Ollerich) Hollis. He was united in marriage to Jolene Richey on October 4, 1953.

Mr. Hollis served in the U.S. Air Force from 1952-1992 where he ranked Chief Master Sergeant, working as Medical Administrative Manager. He also owned and operated Hollis Floor covering in Higginsville where he lived most of his life.
