Lesley E. "Fatty" Borgstadt, 82 of Aullville, Missouri died on Thursday, December 19, 2013, at Lafayette Regional Health Center in Lexington, Missouri.

Born Wednesday, September 16, 1931 in Concordia, Missouri, he was the son of the late August Raymond Borgstadt and the late Marsaline (Duffey) Borgstadt. He married Judith A. Gilkey on Saturday, June 1, 1963.

Mr. Borgstadt served in the Army during the Korean War from 1952 - 1954. He worked as a crew leader for the floor team of the special bridge crew of MoDot, retiring in 1993. He was a lifetime resident of Aullville.
