She was most proud of her monthly meeting with her high school classmates. They were all still getting together 61 years after graduating. She loved to fish, craft, collect magazines, and travel. She enjoyed going to Branson, visiting Walton Mountain, Noah's Ark, Georgia Aquarium and Southfork Ranch in Dallas, Texas. She will be greatly missed.
