July 24, 1928 - July 16, 2012

Lloyd H. Abney, 83 of Higginsville, Missouri died on Monday, July 16, 2012, at St. Luke's East Hospital in Lees Summit, Missouri.

Born Tuesday, July 24, 1928 in Sedalia, Missouri, he was the son of Verdie Abney and Bessie (Hill) Abney. He married Audrey Cramer September 25, 1949.

Mr. Abney served as a Technical Sergeant in the Air Force from 1948 until 1952 and was a Veteran of the Korea War. He lived in Higginsville for the past 46 years where he worked 23 years for A & P Grocery Store, 10 years for Missouri Veterinary Supply, then 9 years as a car sales man at Lotspeich Motors in Warrensburg, retiring in 1994.

He was ordained as a deacon at East Sedalia Baptist Church on January 14, 1962 and received the Deacon Emeritus Recognition on March 22, 2009 at First Baptist Church in Higginsville where he was a member.

Surviving are his wife, Audrey of the home, two sons, Terry (Cyndi) Abney of Higginsville and Steve (Cathy) Abney of Warrensburg, Missouri; one daughter, Dawn (Kevin) Sanders of Higginsville; one sister, Gerry Sumner of Sedalia, Missouri; 8 grand children, Heather Huggins, Courtney Abney, Bryan (Cara) Abney, Marshall (Jessie) Abney, Chelsea Abney, Casey Sanders, Kyle

He was preceded in death by his parents and one sister, Marjorie Dey.

A Funeral service will be held at 2:00 PM on Thursday, July 19, 2012 at the First Baptist Church, 1907 Peach St. Higginsville with Dr. Greg Fine officiating, pianist Doris Cavaness and Dennis Million as soloist.
