Marie Johanna Kalebaugh, 88 of Higginsville, Missouri passed away on Friday, December 16, 2022, at Meyer Care Center.

She was born Tuesday, September 4, 1934 in Mount Vernon, New York, to the late George Mueffelmann and the late Marie Mueffelmann (Eidemann).

Marie was a second generation immigrant, as her parents immigrated to New York from Germany. She graduated from A.B. Davis High School in Mount Vernon and graduated with an Associate's Degree from Concordia College in New York. She was active with extracurricular activities and a cheerleader in college.
