



## Marklin "Mark" D. Kloeppe

August 6, 1969 - January 3, 2019

Marklin "Mark" D. Kloeppe, 49 of Mayview, Missouri died on Thursday, January 3, 2019, in a trucking accident in Madison County, Indiana.

Born Wednesday, August 6, 1969 in Kansas City, Missouri, he was the son of the late Leo Kloeppe and the late Angeline Jacobs Kloeppe. He was the husband of Yao Kloeppe, marrying August 15, 2009.
