



Melvin H. "Mel" Hink

November 18, 1930 - May 10, 2013

Melvin H. "Mel" Hink, age 82 of Higginsville, Missouri died on Friday, May 10, 2013, at his son's home in Overland Park, Kansas.

Born Tuesday, November 18, 1930 in rural Lafayette County near Alma, Missouri, he was the son of Ernest Hink and Adela (Schmidt) Hink. He married Joilene B. Dollar April 21, 1963. She preceded him in death January 1, 2013. Also preceded in death are his parents, a sister, Luella Mehrhoff; and a brother who was stillborn.

Mr. Hink worked 39 years, from 1954 to 1993, at Alma Farmers Co-op in Alma. After retiring from the Co-op, he spent several years at Fuehring Wood Products, a woodworking shop owned by his brother-in-law, Maurice Fuehring. He lived in Higginsville since 1963. He was a 1948 graduate of the Alma High School and a member of Grace United Methodist Church, Higginsville .

Surviving are one son, Rob (Paula) Hink of Overland Park, Kansas; one daughter, Nancy (Den) Trumbull of Montgomery, Alabama; two sisters, Laverne Gruber of Lexington, Missouri, Delsine Fuehring of Higginsville; and 7 grandchildren, Allison (Brady) McGee, Amy, Julie, Den IV, and Kelly Trumbull; Will and Ella Hink.

A Funeral service will be at 11:00 A.M. on Tuesday, May 14, 2013 at Grace United Methodist Church, 16 W. 15th St. Higginsville with Rev. Kyle Evans officiating and Sharon Pragman as organist. Interment will be in the Higginsville City Cemetery.
