Minister Laura J. Pollard, age 68 of Higginsville, Missouri died on Monday, March 18, 2013 at her sister's home in Kansas City, Missouri.

Born Thursday, May 18, 1944 in Kansas City, Missouri, she was the daughter of Robert Stillwell Charles and Louise Christina (Brewster) Charles.

Minister Pollard worked as a Developmental Aide at the Higginsville Habilitation Center in Higginsville where she lived most of her life. She also lived in Blue Springs, Missouri. She was a member of Community Fellowship Church of Jesus Christ in Kansas City, Missouri and was an ordained minister for the Unity in Faith Ministries.
