She was a member of the Carrollton United Methodist Church, a member of the Women's Club, and a member of the Country Club. She loved working in

her flower beds and took great joy in caring for her flowers.

Nancy will be greatly missed and those left to remember her are, husband, Carl of the home; one daughter, Carlene (Jeff) Strathman of Carrollton; and one grandchild, Micah (Kortney) Strathman.

She was preceded in death by her parents; one son, Gary Mais, and one sister, Donna Arth.
