Nora Mildred DeVasher (Clemytes), 93 of Higginsville, Missouri died on Thursday, September 9, 2021, at Western Missouri Medical Center in Warrensburg, Missouri.

She was born Sunday, September 25, 1927 in East St. Louis, Illinois, and was the daughter of Lithuanian immigrant, Michael Clemytes (Clim) and the late Mildred (Matt) Clemytes. Nora's father Michael struggled to find work in America; no one would hire him because of his last name. He changed their last name to Clim to remove the stigma of being an immigrant and to help him find work.

Nora graduated high school and then attended a trade school to study Handwriting Graphologist. She was an expert in her field, and could tell anything about a person's personality just by studying their handwriting. Nora worked as a secretary for Our Lady of the Snows in Belleville, Illinois. In 1982, at the age of 55, Nora moved to Higginsville to help care for her grandchildren. She was a member of the First Baptist Church. Nora enjoyed painting, knitting, crocheting, and doing arts & crafts.

Surviving are one son, Larry Loyd of Altoona, PA; one daughter, Marlene Willits of Higginsville; one sister, Dorothy Lillen of Swan Sea, IL; five grandchildren; and five great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her parents and one brother, Walter Clim. No services are scheduled at this time.
