Ollie Himes, age 99 of Odessa, Missouri, formerly of Corder, Missouri died on Friday, January 25, 2013, at the Golden Living Center in Odessa.

Born Sunday, June 1, 1913 in Corder, she was the daughter of the late Samuel Maycock and the late Ollie Humphrey Maycock. She married Gaither Himes January 21, 1933. He preceded her in death on June 1, 1965. Also preceded in death are five brothers and five sisters.
