Paul Mathew Catron, whose smile could light up any room and whose laughter was truly contagious, passed away on May 26, 2024. Beloved by all who knew him, Paul's humor and genuine spirit left a lasting impression on everyone he met.

Paul was born to Minnette and Larry Catron, grandson of Norma and Ron Catron, all of whom preceded him in death. He is survived by his loving wife, Crystal Catron; his sons, Mathew Catron, Hayden Reid, Josh Cobb (Averi Litherland), and Zach Cobb (Lexus Helming); and his treasured grandchildren, Everleigh and Jameson, who is due earthside on Paul's birthday Aug 6th. He also leaves behind his sister, Jenn Butler (Andrew Butler); his Aunt Kelli Catron (Tracey Mikes); and countless brothers and sisters in arms, as well as friends too numerous to count.

Paul served honorably in the Army and the Missouri Army National Guard for most of his adult life. It was during his service that he met Crystal, and together they dedicated their lives to serving their family and country with honor and dignity.

Paul reveled in watching his boys play and grow, always cheering them on with perhaps a little too much volume and lack of tactful words. He was the embodiment of the spirit that if you want something done right, "ask a Catron." His ability to work miracles, whether in his professional life or when helping a friend in need, was legendary.

Paul was much more than his uniform; he was the life of any party, a

relentless sports enthusiast, and a devoted family man. He was always there to lift his boys up after a fall, most of the time with a chuckle and a joke, helping them learn to laugh at life's small defeats and to cherish its victories. Reflecting on his life, one might recall Robin Williams' poignant words: "The funniest people are often fighting the toughest battles." Paul fought many battles, both seen and unseen, with bravery and a smile.

As we remember Paul, let us not dwell on our loss but celebrate the man who brought so much joy and light into our lives. We will honor his legacy by living our lives with the same generosity and zest that he did.
