Raymond L. Fisher, age 74 of Higginsville, Missouri died on Friday, April 26, 2013, at his home.

Born Tuesday, March 21, 1939 in Higginsville, Missouri, he was the son of Elmer Fisher and Grace Burns Fisher. He married Mary L. Gerkey on August 10, 1957 and she survives of the home.

Raymond served in the U.S. Air Force during the Vietnam War and was a 20 year veteran. He served from 1956-1976 and ranked as Master Sargeant. He then worked at Lake City Arsenal, but was always involved in his farming business. He lived most of his life in the Higginsville area.
