Raymond Edward Plute, 88 of Warrensburg, MO, passed away on Tuesday, June 17, 2025, at Ridge Crest Nursing Center in Warrensburg. He was born Friday, August 23, 1936 in Warrensburg, to the late Charles Plute and the late Bula (Welch) Plute. He attended Warrensburg High School. He married the love of his life, Marjorie (Lucas) Plute on December 20, 1956. They spent 68 wonderful years together.

Raymond was a dedicated, hardworking man who gave many years of service to the Johnson County Roads Department and the local shoe factory in Warrensburg. A skilled horseshoe player, Raymond proudly won several Class A state tournaments at the Missouri State Fair and even placed 11th in the world in 1975. He was also an avid golfer, achieving an incredible nine holes-in-one during his lifetime. He cherished his early mornings on the golf course, playing faithfully until illness kept him away.

Raymond and his wife loved spending time outdoors and making memories. They enjoyed fishing trips, annual getaways to Branson to see the Presley family show, roller derby events, drive-in movies, and family trips to

professional wrestling matches in Sedalia when their two sons were younger. Raymond loved sports of all kinds and had a competitive edge that made him a champion in everything he did. More than anything, he will be remembered for his strong work ethic, his devotion to family, and the joyful spirit he brought to every game, match, and moment in life. His easygoing nature and warm spirit will be deeply missed by all who knew him.

Surviving are his wife, Marjorie of the home; two sons, Gary (Connie) Plute of Knob Noster, MO and Danny Plute of Clarksville, TN. He was preceded in death by his parents; two sisters, Barbara Colister and Barbara Plute.
