Richard Lee Kump, 66 of Scranton, Kansas passed away on Friday, December 27, 2024, while at work. Richard was born on Saturday, November 15, 1958 in Oberlin, Kansas, to the late Rev. Jay Kump and the late Mahee Kump (Miller). Richard was a graduate of Jennings High School in Jennings, Kansas, class of 1976. From his early youth through adulthood, Richard loved restoring mustangs and working on them. He loved his Ford Mustang Mach 1. Richard was a truck driver and farmer for most of his adult life. With those careers, he was always a man to be wearing his cowboy boots and hat. He is remembered as a simple, kind man who loved everybody. Richard had a true love for farming. He enjoyed planting and harvesting his wheat fields and working the cattle, even driving a cattle truck for a while. While on the farm, Richard loved to do some simple target shooting with his guns, but he never hunted as he “couldn’t hurt or kill an animal.” Richard was a social man and loved his friends. Sometimes he would just want to kick back and enjoy a cold beer with his friends. He loved people and would hand candy out to children whenever he would see them. Richard never met a stranger.

Richard grew up with a minister as his father, so he was a very religious person as well. He attended the Methodist Church in Jennings, Kansas. Through Richard’s love for helping others he often helped run the Boys Home in Dodge City, Kansas. Richard married Pam Christensten in 2015, she survives at the home.

Richard was preceded in death by his parents; Pam’s son, Waymon Cotten;

aunts, Dorothy Kump and Annie Kump; and an uncle, Virgil Kump. He is survived by his wife, Pam Christensten, and special friends, Chris (Lela Henderson) Stehlik. No services are scheduled at this time.
