Richard E. Werning, age 78 of Higginsville, Missouri died on Monday, November 12, 2012, at Meyer Care Center in Higginsville.

Born Sunday, June 24, 1934 in Higginsville, he was the son of the late Charles Werning and the late Ida (Tempel) Werning. Also preceded in death are three brothers, John, Ralph and Elmer Werning; and one sister, Marie Mittelhauser.
