Robert J. Harrison, age 89 of Raleigh, North Carolina, formerly of Concordia, Missouri, died on Saturday, December 1, 2012, at Alamance Regional Medical Center in Burlington, North Carolina.

Born Saturday, April 21, 1923 in Dover, Missouri, he was the son of the late Jefferson S. Harrison and the late Lorene (Lieser) Harrison. Also preceded in death is one brother, Ross Lee Harrison, one sister, Edith Jo Harrison, and one grandson.

Mr. Harrison founded The Corder Manufacturing Company in 1960. He was also the founder and operator of the Ozark Camper Factory in Concordia, retiring in 1973. He served in the U.S. Navy during World War II ranking Seaman First Class. He was a former member of the Concordia Lions Club, Loyal Order of Moose, and the Jefferson City, Missouri American Legion Post.

He formerly lived in Corder, Concordia and Branson, Missouri, moving to Diamond City, Arkansas and then moving to North Carolina in 2010.

Surviving are five daughters, Rebecca (Jim) Hale of Henley, Missouri, Roberta Sue Collins of Lauderdale Lakes, Florida, Deborah (Sam) Boland of Vero Beach, Florida, Sandra Harrison of Lake City, Florida and Patricia Harrison of Chapel Hill, North Carolina; one step-daughter, Sheila Lea (Herman) Gose of

Hampton, Illinois; 16 grand children; 17 great grand children and five great great grandchildren.
