



## Robert L. Ostermeyer

August 26, 1921 - April 23, 2018

Robert L. Ostermeyer, 96 of Warrensburg, Missouri died on Monday, April 23, 2018, at Western Missouri Medical Center in Warrensburg, Missouri.

Born Friday, August 26, 1921 in Blackburn, Missouri, he was the son of the late Wesley Ostermeyer and the late Ella Hanneman Ostermeyer. He married Lois Fears Ostermeyer on June 16, 1947 and she preceded him in death on May 7, 2014.

He graduated from Higginsville High School in 1939. He served in the Army during World War II from 1942-1946 ranking as a Staff Sergeant. He was a clothing store manager for Harry Smith's store in Lexington, MO for 31 years and retired in 1981.
