Ronald D. Gesch, 62 of Concordia, Missouri died on Thursday, July 19, 2012, at Lenoir Wood Nursing Home in Columbia, Missouri.

Born Wednesday, July 20, 1949 in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, he was the son of Arthur Gesch and Gertrude Schultz Gesch.

Mr. Gesch graduated from the Lutheran High School in Milwaukee, WI., received his teaching degree in Seward, NE. and attained his Master of Arts degree in 2003 from the Concordia University in River Forest, IL.

He moved to Higginsville from Jefferson City, Missouri in 1998 when he became the principal and teacher at Immanuel Lutheran School and also a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church . He had previously taught at the Lutheran School in Honey Creek, Lockwood and Jefferson City; all in Missouri; and additionally taught at the Lutheran School in Springfield, Illinois and Bernham, Texas.
